### Introduction

It defines what our various missions have in common and lays the basis for trust and clarity, both internally and externally. The value principles presented here form an ethical governance document for the present day and the future.

- ▶ to work against alienation, division and intolerance

- ▶ is based on the golden rule of treating others as one's self would wish to be treated
- ▶ is to provide support to vulnerable and excluded people
- ▶ is a concrete expression of peace through interfaith dialogue and action
- ▶ is creating space for people to take their faith and their lives seriously
- ▶ is based on the belief that God is merciful and loving and the creator of heaven and earth
